



## LACE WEST 2026 LACE IN A CASE CHALLENGE ENTRY FORM



Migration is the theme of the Lace West week. With this theme in mind, we are offering a challenge: **'Lace in a Case'** for exhibition at the conference.

There will be three sections to the challenge.

1. Do you have some heirloom lace which a relative, or person known to you, brought to Australia? Do you know a story about the lace? Or
2. Do you have a piece of lace which you would pack in your suitcase if you were migrating? Why would you include this piece of lace? Or
3. Perhaps you are a migrant and you did travel with some lace. Why did you bring that particular piece?

The challenge is to bring the lace for display with an explanation as to why you chose this lace. What is its story? You do not need to include a case with the lace, but if you have a tiny case, it would be welcome for the display! We look forward to many stories illustrating the migrant experience.
